The Beaches Educational Foundation is a non-profit organization that began as the shared idea of local businessmen and educators. The concept was to develop a non-profit foundation that would be able to provide financial assistance to academically capable students at Fletcher High School who, because of financial difficulties, might not otherwise be able to attend college, a vocational program or public service academy.

Upcoming Duncan U. Fletcher high school graduates seeking a higher education at an accredited institution (community, state, private or other) are eligible. This scholarship is based on financial need, merit, and the ability to be successful in a post-secondary course of study. The Ragans, Sutton and Taylor Scholarship Program is presented by Beaches Educational Foundation and awards scholarships in an amount up to \$10,000.

Students who are preparing for a career dedicated to serving others may also apply for the Eddie Bounds Scholarship. This scholarship will be a one-time award of \$1,000.
